Our hearts go out to everyone who has been affected by this pandemic. Here is our update as of late this afternoon October 2nd, 2020.

The University of the Nations Kona (UofNK) is continuing precautions to prevent COVID-19 cases. Preventive measures have been in place since August. These measures have enabled quick identification of cases through contact tracing, targeted testing, and the immediate isolation of individuals. With the utmost care and concern for our campus community and our Local Kona community, UofNK has suspended all in person classes and business as a precautionary measure. All campus activities are being conducted through digital platforms and only essential workers are present on campus.

In response to this situation, UofNK members are undergoing widespread testing and we are treating this with the highest level of attention. UofNK has been serving the communities of the Big Island through delivering food, counseling services, and helping vulnerable populations within our community for the past 50 years. Some of our long term residential staff have been providing assistance in the community since the onset of the pandemic. We are taking every precaution available to protect and care for our Kupuna and other at-risk members of our Big Island Community.
