Results Back: Widespread Testing Identifies a Total of 9 Cases.

The University of the Nations Kona (UofN Kona) campus, located at 75-5851 Kuakini Hwy, Kailua-Kona, HI 96740.

In a collaborative effort to curb the spread of COVID, 955 individuals were tested on our campus this past week. All results from the widespread testing have now come back. Today we are reporting 6 new cases from the balance of the results. All these individuals had been in travel quarantine since September 24th, and continue to be in isolation.

We are encouraged by the results of the widespread testing, as a total of 9 cases from this group represents less than a 1% positive rate.

Today 10 individuals were cleared by the Department of Health and released from isolation. This brings our total active cases to 24. All individuals have mild symptoms and to date no one has been hospitalized.

The Mayor's office has given permission for all individuals with negative results to be released from lockdown for which we are very grateful. We honor our medical team and the Department of Health, who have worked together to contain the spread of COVID-19 in our community. We remain vigilant and committed the safety of our staff, students, and the people of Hawaii County.
