This evening UofN Kona is pleased again to report no new cases on Tuesday, October 13. We are now down to 18 active cases. All remain in isolation under close supervision and only minor symptoms have been reported. To date no one has been hospitalized.

We remain committed and vigilant in wearing masks, social distancing, digital learning and digital meetings. We are grateful for our Campus Medical Team and the Department of Health for all the guidance as we continue to understand the science of this virus.

As an additional level of protection for our surrounding community, the Mayor's office has asked for a second round of testing for our staff and students at the University. This testing will be accomplished on Thursday, October 15th. The safety and care of our campus and the community of the Big Island is our utmost concern.
