## No New Cases Friday - 10/16/20

The University of the Nations Kona (UofN Kona) campus, located at 75-5851 Kuakini Hwy, Kailua-Kona, HI 96740.

This evening, UofN Kona is pleased again to report no new cases on Friday, October 16. We are now down to 12 active cases. All remain in isolation under close supervision. To date, no one has been hospitalized.

Our Campus Medical Team and the Department of Health have been extremely swift and vigilant in dealing with the spread of this virus, for which we are very grateful. We would like to also thank our staff and student body for their cooperation in slowing the spread and doing their part to protect the wider island community.

While we had been expecting an additional round of testing to be performed yesterday, the testing was cancelled by the Mayor's office. We are thankful that the Mayor's office has given permission for all individuals who tested negative to be out of quarantine, and that our campus no longer has to be on voluntary lockdown. We continue to have a heightened state of preventative measures in place to prevent any further spread and remain vigilant.

The Mayor's office offered praise to our medical team and their commitment to completely control the spread of this virus in the University and cooperate with his initiatives to make Kona a safer place.

As always, the safety of our staff, students, and the residents of the Big Island remains our top priority.
