No New Cases Reported Today

The University of the Nations Kona (UofN Kona) campus, located at 75-5851 Kuakini Hwy, Kailua-Kona, HI 96740.

UofN Kona would like to confirm that ongoing testing has revealed no new cases reported on Sunday, October 4. Additionally, we are happy to report one individual has been cleared by the Department of Health (DOH) and released from Quarantine. We continue to monitor the health and safety of all in quarantine with the utmost diligence.

UofN Kona has implemented strict operational procedures since our phased reopening over the summer. These operational procedures were submitted to and reviewed by the Department of Health in August of 2020. We continue to adhere to Mayor Harry Kim's request for stay-at-home until the DOH confirms all appropriate procedures are in place.

None of the 16 cases reported yesterday are connected to the September Quarter student body who arrived recently. These students have remained in quarantine since their arrival, as mandated by the State.

UofN Kona leadership is in close communication with the Department of Health and local County authorities. We continue to strictly adhere to CDC guidelines including mask wearing, social distancing, and all measures to mitigate the risk of infection. We are happy to report that everyone is doing well and only minor symptoms are reported.
